A reading from the second letter of Saint Paul to Timothy

Remember Jesus Gnrist, raised from the dead, a descendant of David—that is my gospel, for which I suffer hardship, even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained. Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, so that they may also obtain the salvation that is it. Christ Jesus, with eternal glory.
