



## Worship Times

10.00am Parish Eucharist (Sundays)

This is a traditional service (with Choir), lasting for just over an hour and is for all age groups.

Refreshments in the Refectory follow the service

8.30am Morning Prayer/6.00pm Evening Prayer (Daily)

Service of Psalms, Bible readings and prayers, lasting for half an hour.

8.00-9.00pm Quiet Abbey (Tuesdays)

This is an opportunity for silent prayer and meditation, for a short time, or up to an hour, ending with Compline (Night Prayer) for those wishing to stay.

10.00am Rosary Prayers (the first Wednesday of the month)

The Rosary Prayers provide a focused and prayer-centred preparation for the offering of the Eucharist (Holy Communion).

10.30am Holy Communion (Wednesdays)

The weekly Holy Communion service is in a traditional format and is followed by refreshments in the Refectory.
